We are recruiting a Project Coordinator for an initial period of 12 months to lead our work in 2021 and hopefully beyond. The postholder will be responsible for coordinating all of the activities and projects of **Grow 73**. This is an extremely broad based and challenging role which will encompass the following:

- Transforming land in Overtoun Park, Rutherglen to become an accessible garden with facilities for the local community to gather, grow, learn and have fun.
- Delivery of our Pollinator Pathway Project which will create a biodiversity corridor from Rutherglen train station to Cathkin.
- Development and delivery of a programme of gardening sessions
- Development and delivery of other projects which promote sustainable lifestyles and foster community cohesion in the Rutherglen and Cambuslang areas
- Building the capacity of **Grow 73** through fundraising, policy development and quality improvement.
- Managing, recruiting and supporting sessional staff and volunteers

This is a fixed term post for 23 hours per week for 12 months from January 1st to December 31st 2021, with the likely prospect of extension beyond. We guarantee that this will be a year when you will work hard but equally have a fun and rewarding experience.
